a home to provide shelter in any season.



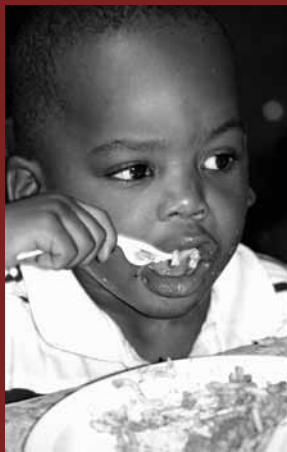
